Funding Requests are not in event based group, rather request are to be able to provide services versus actual goods.

Review of events put on by Student Government-

- Welcome Back BBQ- very successful
- Meet the Police
- Dolphin Discount Program- 1200 flyers posted to benefit students. Open to students/faculty/staff to enjoy (cost \$350/yr)
- Mascot
- Leadership Right
- CA student summit for higher education
- Pizza w/Pres (1st week of school)- would like to continue with and conduct event more than one semester. Will need to conduct more advertising about event few days prior.
- Political Party event- questionable to continue next year. Need to make available for different issues that would arise such as local elections, political active organizations and associations.
 - *Dr. Sawyer – remind of 2006 school board elections. Mandated by chancellors ofc need to conduct event, makes most sense for SG conduct event due to it being political based.*
 - Election Day event- food made available along with coverage of election.
- Blood Drive to hold event every 13 weeks. Vendor provides own advertising of event. This year there was a descent turnout would like to continue with program.
 - Need to use United Blood Services program that benefits and helps the tri counties, our local community (mandated by Pres Ofc).
- Mascot Tryouts very successful (Low cost event at \$8.13). Provided ice/water to participants left over from 'Meet the Police' event.
 - Events that Mascot participates in will have team evaluate event and attendance and look to obtain feedback regarding interest of continuing participation with event.
- Hand across CI provides a sense of community and school spirit. Goal with this event is to increase school spirit amongst students. SPB Board will continue with this event next year.
 - Located in N. Quad included student/housing/faculty/staff participation of approximately 1000 participants. Received much Kudos for campus spirit. Event highlights deal with mass interdisciplinary student organizations that pull together with the support of SG-interdisciplinary political policy (support o/organization). This event received press coverage.

- Halloween Carnival- sponsored event for people and children of community that provided safe event for community to attend and participate in.
 - Student Leadership and Development will not conduct Haunted House for 2005-2006. Event needs to come through SG funding due to cost not feasible with budget (time/efforts) of SLD. Event may be a great way for other clubs/orgs to get involved and interact with community.
 - Harvest Party (Dr. Sawyer) – SG are and do consistently, but make whole resources tight. Need to remain whole not just one, but many things. Example, Hands across CI make the campus whole. Example, Halloween Carnival, spirit of students comes from the heart this is what counts.
- Spirit Day Thursday – students wear school colors/school gear and get free food in return. The main point of this event is to make students aware of where they are in terms of campus and it promotes school pride.
- Holiday Party – very multicultural event which allows participants to learn about different cultures and how different cultures celebrate the holiday season differently.
- Leadership retreat – event held at Shalom Institute two events held during Fall/Spring semester sponsored by OSLD/SG. First event was determined to be too short and second event was determined to be a little bit more relaxed which allowed for more team building between clubs/orgs to get to know each other.

BUDGET

- Clubs/Orgs are guaranteed 30% of funding from budget due to it being a big part of SG. Clubs/Orgs is determined to establish leadership opportunities on campus for students.
 - NACA – part of student programming not recommended for SG to fund, instead SPB
- Alcohol Awareness – Sen. Meyers help distribute core survey

 - Food services try to bring prices down and find better services for students to purchase meal plans
