 - a. ACTION ITEM: Approval of minutes from February 12, 2026

- 5) Public Forum: *None*
- 6) Reports:
 - a. Student Government (E. Conde)
 - i. Lobby Corps held a meeting with legislators, marking the first time in over a decade that they have engaged in this level of advocacy and representation.
 - ii. Student representatives met with assembly members to express interest in attending a future Senate meeting and strengthening collaborative relationships with state officials.
 - iii. Plans are underway to develop and distribute a comprehensive student survey aimed at assessing the overall student experience at CSU Channel Islands.
 - b. Student Programming Board (K. Munoz)
 - i. The “Together We Craft” event series was held on February 24 and March 2, providing students with creative and community-building opportunities.
 - ii. “Foodie Tuesday” took place on March 10, offering students a chance to engage with diverse food experiences on campus.
 - iii. “Trivia Throwdown” is scheduled to take place on March 24, designed to encourage student participation through interactive and competitive activities.
 - iv. A screening of *The Devil Wears Prada* movie is scheduled for March 25 at the Roxy Movie Theater, expanding programming beyond campus and enhancing student engagement through off-site events.

- c. Student Union (A.J. Antonio)
 - i. Modified operating hours were implemented during Spring Break (March 16–20); the Sea Store and Ekho’s Café were closed for the duration of the break.
 - ii. “Rock Your Crocs” events were held on February 26 and March 12, providing students with a fun and customizable activity.
 - iii. “Grocery Plinko” was held on March 11, with an additional event scheduled for April 13, aimed at supporting student needs through interactive resource distribution.
 - iv. A book giveaway in recognition of Women’s History Month took place on March 4, promoting awareness and educational engagement.
 - v. A second book giveaway is planned for April 2 in celebration of AAPI Heritage Month, continuing efforts to highlight diverse voices and cultures.
 - vi. The “Spring Crawl,” a seasonal follow-up to the October “Candy Crawl,” is scheduled for April 8 and will offer a themed, campus-wide engagement experience.
- d. The CI View (T. Walker)
 - i. The team has gained access to abandoned campus buildings for the purpose of investigative reporting and feature writing.
 - ii. The organization continues to collaborate closely with its intern team to produce content and support publication efforts.

 - i. Budget Allocation & Spending Committee (E. Conde)
 - 1. The BASC Committee reported that they will reconvene following Spring Break and will provide additional updates at the next Board meeting.

 - 2. The Election Council discussed ongoing election outreach efforts, including increased Instagram promotion, campus tabling, and email communications to encourage student candidacy.
 - 3. Outreach efforts at the Foodie Tuesday tabling event were successful, with all promotional tickets distributed within the first hour and strong initial student interest, though engagement declined after incentives were gone.
 - 4. Candidate preparation initiatives faced challenges, as previously hosted workshops had no attendance; the Council discussed exploring alternative methods to better support and engage prospective candidates moving forward.

 - ii. The priority deadline for ASI Hiring for the 2026–2027 academic year has passed, and recruitment efforts will continue with all positions remaining open until filled.

 - i. The Board reviewed current budget totals for the 2025–2026 fiscal year alongside projected enrollment figures for 2026–2027.
 - ii. Discussion focused on anticipated budget planning scenarios based on varying enrollment projections.
 - iii. It was noted that ASI operations are primarily funded through student fees, making enrollment trends a key factor in determining the organization’s budget for the upcoming year.
