What's on the Ballot?

The current fee: \$75/ semester



Proposed Phased Increase:

- +\$20 in 2026-27 (\$95 per semester)
- +\$20 in 2027-28 (\$115 per semester)
- Annual HEPI % adjustments starting 2028-29

The proposed increase would be an added \$20 per semester in fall 2026, then an added \$20 per semester in fall 2027, bringing the total fee to \$115 per semester/\$230 per year by 27-28, followed by a small HEPI percentage for inflation thereafter.
