## CSUCI Fraternity & Sorority - Academic Requirements

Recognized fraternities and sororities at CSUCI are expected to promote the academic achievement of its members. With this in mind, the following academic requirements must be followed:

## General Information

- 1. Each semester (fall and spring), the total chapter must achieve a 2.0 GPA or above.
- 2. Each semester (fall and spring), the new member class must achieve a 2.0 GPA or above.
- 3. No potential new members may go through formal or informal recruitment without having a 2.0 GPA or above for both cumulative and previous completed semester. (This does not apply to a freshman student.)
- 4. The chapter GPA and new member class GPA computation is based upon December and April Roster Updates. Once the roster update is completed, no changes will be made.

## **Academic Probation**

- 1. Chapters (total chapter) that fail to achieve a minimum 2.0 GPA will be placed on academic probation.
- 2. Chapters whose New Member class fails to achieve a minimum 2.0 GPA will be placed on academic probation.
- 3. A new member that fails to achieve a 2.0 GPA will be placed on academic probation.
- 4. Academic probation lasts for one semester and consists of required chapter programming, significant reduction in chapter activities and individual member assistance/monitoring.
  - Failure to complete the provisions in a timely manner may result in a change in the chapter's or individuals' status in the chapter or at the University as a whole.
- 5. If the chapter (total chapter) achieves a 2.0 GPA or higher at the conclusion of the probation, the Academic Probation will be lifted.

## **Academic Suspension**

- 1. If the chapter (total chapter) fails to achieve a 2.0 GPA at the end of the Academic Probation, the chapter will be placed on Academic Suspension.
- 2. Academic Suspension lasts for one semester and consists of a total cessation of chapter activities. Failure to abide by the terms of the Academic Suspension may result in a change in the chapter's recognition status.
- 3. To be removed from Academic Suspension, the chapter (total chapter) must achieve above a 2.0 GPA at the conclusion of the probationary period.
- 4. Failure to achieve a 2.0 GPA or higher will result in the loss of University recognition for a minimum of one academic year.
