A meeting of the Budget Allocation and Spending Committee (BASC) will be held on Friday, February 24, 2017 at 7:45 a.m., pursuant to Education Code Section 89921 et seq., at California State University Channel Islands, Student Union Meeting Room A, located at One University Drive, Camarillo, CA 93012, to consider and act upon the following matters:

 - 1. Total Request: \$3,000
 - Questions identified for follow up with the student organization:
 a. Is the Passover event on or off campus?

 - 4. If Passover is an off-campus event, funding would be cut by \$600. If the event is on campus, full funding would be granted.
