 - a. DISCUSSION ITEM: Applicant Update (S. Mercado)
 - i. All four applicants came to campaign workshops, meaning they are all official candidates and can begin campaigning March 27, 2023, at 8am.
- 7) New Business:
 - a. DISCUSSION ITEM: Required Candidate Workshop PowerPoint Debrief (S. Mercado)
 - i. Only one workshop was held as all 4 applicants attended the same one. The PowerPoint went well, there was good engagement and questions being asked.
 - ii. Student had an inquiry regarding if SOI members are not allowed to endorse.
 - b. DISCUSSION ITEM: Student Inquiry for SOI Election Code Policy Debrief
 - i. Members of the council discussed the Election Code in regards to SOI members being on campaign teams.
 1. Members of the council reviewed the election code to evaluate this point.
 2. It was decided that at this time SOI is not written properly in the ASI Election Code or ASI Bylaws, and thus SOI members can be on campaign teams as long as their campaigning work does not interfere with their work in SOI or while they are working in the ASI Suite.
 3. The Chair will email the candidate who asked this question, with the above decision.

- c. DISCUSSION ITEM: Channel Your Vote Marketing Plan (S. Mercado)
 - i. Suggestions of posting earlier for Channel Your Vote, around the week before Spring Break.

 - iii. Creating notes for March 27th posting dates. Discussion on what is most engaging on social media.
