- 6) Outstanding Business:
 - a. DISCUSSION ITEM: Hearings (S. Mercado)
 - i. No complaints have been submitted at this time.
 - b. DISCUSSION ITEM: Channel Your Vote Events Debrief (S. Mercado)
 - i. Tuesdays, Channel Your Vote event was a little confusing in terms of traffic, since we wanted them to check-in first with Foodie Tuesday, before coming to vote. The Council believes some stanchions or a-frames with directions would be helpful to guide where students should go first.
 - ii. Making Tuesday a collaboration was very helpful as it got more students there, whereas compared to Wednesday, it was not as busy, which the weather did not help with.
 - iii. Food Trucks in general catch people's eye, so maybe food trucks for both events, might help with traffic.
 - iv. Having Ekho out at the events would be a suggestion for next year, which brings good energy.
 - v. If there are extra volunteers, asking them to go walk around and encourage people to come over to the event, so the table is not so crowded.
 - vi. Free food is always a good incentive to keep for the future.
 - vii. Would recommend collaborating with Student Programming Board again.
 - viii. Tuesday at least 150 came to the event and Wednesday there were about 80.
 - ix. Giveaway
 - 1. 19 students entered the Instagram story giveaway to win an Ekho Bobblehead or Plushie. 8 students won.

7) New Business:

- a. INFORMATIONAL ITEM: Election Results (S. Mercado)
 - i. All candidates running for office were elected. The candidate who ran for more than one position has 7 days to confirm which position they will serve in.

- ii. Four students had technical issues voting, were verified by Advisor Block-Weiss that they were eligible and had not already voted. Meaning that Advisor Block-Weiss took down their votes by hand and when the ballot was verified, those votes were added 4/12/23.
- iii. A typo was found on the Ballot Results post on the website and thus was updated on 4/13/23.
- iv. On a cool data note, for last year we had 408 students vote out of 6844 eligible voters, which means 5.96% of the student body voted, whereas for this year we had 321 students vote out of 5286 eligible voters, giving us a 6.07% of the student body voted!
