 - i. The Council looked at the class availability schedule of the candidate

 - iii. The Council brainstormed some ideas to engage students:

 - 2. H. Alatorre shared that also the responsibility should be on the candidates to promote and campaign for themselves and get their faces out there.
 - 3. The Council discussed that their emphasis should be on encouraging the students to truly vote. A suggestion was shared to have a smaller event for the candidates to have a discussion and then having a bigger event about actually voting.
 - 4. The Council agreed on doing a similar event to last year, but doing it outside.

 - b. Student Union Courtyard
 - c. Market on social media, ask the candidates to market as well
 - d. Next week the council will look at script and questions for the event
 - e. The ASI office will reach out to the candidates
 - f. The event will be called "Meet the Candidates"
 - g. The chair read over the questions that were used last year at the event.
 - i. The Council will review the candidates platforms and decide if any questions should be tailored to the candidates platforms
 - 1. The Council brainstormed hashtags to generate questions from the student body on social media platforms.
 - a. #askyourasicandidates
 - 5. First day of voting the Council decided to have a larger scale event.
 - a. We could use the Student Union grass near Central Mall
 - 6. K. Hamilton will work on a Meet the Candidate digital materials.
- v. K. Hamilton shared that the candidate's info would be posted on the website.
- vi. The Council decided that the vote event would be:
 - 1. Channel your Vote event
 - 2. Student Union Lawn
 - 3. Tuesday, April 16, 11:30am-1:30pm
 - 4. I voted stickers
